To meet the sonic expectations of the young and the young at heart, Meinl has added 21" and 22" medium crashes, as well as a 24" medium ride to its Byzance series cymbals.

"Many of today's most happening drummers such as Aaron Gillespie with Underoath, Nate Young with Anberlin, Zac Farro with Paramore, Jean Paul Guster with Clutch and Spencer Smith with Panic! At the Disco have used our existing Byzance series for quite some time now." comments Meinl's Director of Artist Relations Norbert Saemann. "After discovering their love for the Byzance series, they began requesting larger crashes and rides to achieve that monster sound that they want to hear. We also received many special orders from our customers who had similar needs and from customers who are fans of our artists who are using these bigger sized crashes and rides. We took our artist's advice and the feedback from the market into serious consideration and are now offering these sizes officially within our existing Byzance series."

Meinl's Byzance series cymbals are hand-hammered in Meinl's own Turkish factory from B20 bronze alloy. They produce a warm and dark, yet full bodied sound. They are used by almost every Meinl artist worldwide.
